

How do plants grow and why are they important?


Focus Questions:

Home Connection:

- 1) Grow a plant at home! Observe it everyday, noticing if it needs more sunlight or water and how it is growing. Take pictures or videos and compare them throughout the growing process.
- 2) Try a well known science experiment at home. Buy 2 types of plants and play calming relaxing music for one and speak to it kindly and lovingly. For the other plant, play jarring music (heavy metal perhaps?!) and don't speak lovingly to it. Make sure to give them both the same amount of water and sunlight. See how they grow and thrive under these different conditions!
- 3) Visit your local plant nursery/plant shop. A wonderful suggestion is Urban Garden Center on East 116th street! Treat yourself to a new plant friend and ask the staff some questions about the plants they sell.
